

2-6) Self-sterility in *Tripsacum australis*. In the three clones, derived from the original material collected by Cutler, two are definitely self-sterile, while the self-sterility is less complete in the third. It should be interesting to find out how wide self-sterility is present in other species of *Tripsacum*. A clone of *T. laxum* never did seed, while this a clone from tetraploid *dactyloides* produces some seeds.

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
