2-6) <u>Self-sterility in Tripsacum australis</u>. In the three clones, derived from the original material collected by Cutler, two are definitely self-sterile, while the self-sterility is less complete in the third. It should be interesting to find out how wide self-sterility is present in other species of Tripsacum. A clone of T. laxum never did seed, while this a clone from tetraploid dactyloides produces some seeds.

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
