The collection in the past year resulted in the following increase of the stocks: Indigenous races: Guianas-38 samples, mainly orange flint and some dent-flint infiltrates; Southern margin of Amazon Basin-19 samples from three tribes, all belonging to interlocked racial groups. Commercial races: Argentina-55 samples of the main types Colorado, Amarillo, Cuarenton and Amargo, Southern States of Brasil- Parana and St. Catarina 100 samples and Rio Grande do Sul 790 samples. Sao Paulo State 800 samples. Not these samples have been classified yet, but the total in our called has grown from 826 last year's report to about 2,700.
